SACRIFICES OF PRAISE

Hebrews 13:9-21

AIM: To understand the significance of steadfast faith and prayer, grace over legalism, love and unity among believers, and strong leadership.

KEY VERSE: "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise --- the fruit of lips that openly profess his name. - Hebrews 13:15

CONCEPTS

- 1. God's grace—not food rules—is your true strength. (v.9)
- 2. Jesus suffered and died outside the city to make us holy. (vv.11-12)
- 3. Christians must be willing to share in Christ's reproach and endure rejection. (vv.13-14)
- 4. Praise and worship matters, but our Christian duty does not end there. (vv.15-16)
- 5. Believers should trust and submit to God's appointed leaders. (v.17a)
- 6. Joyful leaders bless those they serve. (v.17b)
- 7. Pray for leaders' faithful service, highlighting shared integrity and honor. (vv.18-19)
- 8. Pray that God equips believers to live pleasing lives through Christ. (vv. 20-21)
