JEREMIAH'S RESCUE

Jeremiah 38:7-13

Lesson Aim: To understand how God uses unexpected people to accomplish His rescue plan, and to encourage them to trust in God's sovereignty and speak up courageously when others are in need.

Key Verse: "Then the king commanded Ebed-Melek the Cushite, "Take thirty men from here with you and lift Jeremiah the prophet out of the cistern before he dies." – Jeremiah 38:10

CONCEPTS:

- 1. God uses people outside the expected circle to accomplish His purposes. (vv. 38:7)
- 2. For the sake of righteousness, speak up when others remain silent, even if we risk comfort.(vv. 38:8-9)
- 3. When our actions are compassionate and pure, God will soften the hearts of our enemies and reward our courage. (v. 10)
- 4. God is present in suffering and sends help in His timing and way. (vv. 11-13)
