God's Word

Psalm 19:7-13; 2 Timothy 3:14-15

Lesson Aim: To understand the nature, purpose, and transforming power of God's Word, and to encourage a deeper commitment to applying the Word to life daily.

Key Verse: "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work." – 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Lesson Concepts:

- 1. God's Word is flawless and dependable, bringing life, direction, and wisdom to all who follow it. (Psalm 19:7)
- 2. God's commands are pure, right, and true, revealing what pleases Him and how we should live. (vv. 19:8-9)
- 3. The Word of God is more valuable than material wealth and more satisfying than earthly pleasures. (Psalm 19:10)
- 4. Scripture warns us, keeps us from sin, and leads us to a life of integrity and righteousness. (Psalm 19:11-13)
- 5. Remain committed to God's Word, taught by trusted teachers who guided us in truth. (2 Tim. 3:14)
- 6. In addition to wisdom, God's Word reveals the truth of and salvation through Christ by faith. (2 Tim. 3:15)
