Welcoming Others to Christ

Acts 10:9-15; 30-35; Galatians 3:28-29

LESSON AIM: To help believers understand that God welcomes all people to Christ without favoritism and to reflect this truth by breaking down barriers and embracing everyone as one family in Jesus Christ.

Key Verse: *"Then Peter began to speak. 'now realize how true it is that God does not show Favoritism but accepts from every nation the one who fears him and does what is right.'"*

- **Acts 10:34-35**

CONCEPTS:

1. Obedience to God may require unlearning favoritism-held traditions.
(vv. 14)
2. God corrects religious assumptions that limit who he accepts.
(vv. 13-15)
3. God's salvation is offered without ethnic or cultural favoritism.
(vv. 34-35)
4. Faith in Christ removes spiritual divisions between people.
(v. Galatians 3:28)
5. Every Believer shares equal inheritance in God's family.
(v. Galatians 3:29)
