Living in Christian Community

Matthew 28:18-20; Hebrews 10:22-25

Lesson Aim: To understand and express that Christians are called to actively share their faith while also building and sustaining a supportive, committed community of believers.

Key Verse: Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. ~ **Hebrews 10:23**

Concepts:

Matthew

1. God ascribed all authority and power in heaven and earth to Jesus Christ. (v. 18)
2. Believers are commanded to share the gospel and make true followers of Christ. (v19a)
3. True discipleship requires spiritual dedication and active obedience through instruction. (vv. 19b-20a)
4. Jesus promises that Christians are never alone in their mission to make disciples. (v.20b)

Hebrews

5. Christ has accomplished everything necessary for our fellowship with God. (v.22)
6. Christians are called to stand confident in Christ's salvation and to live accordingly. (v.23)
7. Giving and receiving encouragement are vital practices for every obedient believer. (v. 24)
8. Christians are called to fellowship for discipleship, mutual care, and shared encouragement. (v.25)
