## Christian Manner of Justice

Deuteronomy 24:14-21, Ephesians 6:5-9 & Timothy 6:17-19

**AIM: Work as unto the LORD; be generous and willing to share.**

**KEY VERSE:** *When you are harvesting in your field and you overlook a sheaf, do not go back to get it. Leave it for the foreigner, the fatherless, and the widow, so that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands. -Deuteronomy 24:19*

### CONCEPTS:

1. We should not oppress hired workers, especially the poor, foreigners, and widows. (Duet. 24:14)
2. Workers must be paid as agreed, because their livelihood depends on it. (Duet. 24:15)
3. Each person is responsible for their own actions. (Duet. 24:16)
4. Because we love God, we treat people justly. (Duet. 24:17-21)
5. We should show faithfulness when no one is watching. (Eph. 6:5-6)
6. God cares about how we behave, work, and treat others. (Eph. 6:7)
7. God shows NO favoritism; He rewards good works! (Eph. 6:8-9)
8. God is our source for everything; wealth is a byproduct. (1 Tim. 6:17)
9. We are **called** to bless others with our resources. (1 Tim. 6:18-19)
