

Judges 4:4-10, 14, 21-22

LESSON AIM: To recognize and explain how God uses unexpected people and faithful obedience to manifest His sovereignty and secure victory over opposition.

Key Verse: Now Deborah, a prophet, the wife of Lappidoth, was leading Israel at that time. She held court under the Palm of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in the hill country of Ephraim, and the Israelites went up to her to have their disputes decided. **—Judges 4:4-5**

CONCEPTS

1. God can use unconventional tools, unexpected actions, and anyone for His purposes. (Vv. 4-5 & 21)
2. God provides the power for every task He assigns; obedience secures the victory. (Vv. 6-7)
3. God uses our actions of obedience even when our faith is shaky. (Vv.8-10)
4. No oppressor is too powerful for God; He can instantly overturn any advantage. (v.22)
